Training to be a Deacon. The admission process for a deacon is similar to that for a priest. After a preparatory year, those candidates considered suitable and are accepted must begin a three-year formation programme, with classes held mostly at weekends. This is a substantial commitment to the study of Scripture, Theology, Liturgy and Canon Law. The rich tradition of Christian spirituality will be a key part of the formation period. Other aspects will include the development of personal and pastoral skills, and a pastoral placement for a time in the diocese.
