Good News on Vocations for Clogher Diocese

Two young men from County Monaghan have answered the call to share in the mission of the Church by recently beginning formation and academic programmes which will, hopefully, lead to them being ordained priests for the Diocese of Clogher. In addition, another man, from Enniskillen, is undertaking formation and academic preparation for the permanent diaconate. This good news comes as the Catholic Church throughout the world marks an Extraordinary Month of Mission, declared by Pope Francis in order to focus on the vital contribution that all Catholics can play in proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ and making his message known to all people, at home and elsewhere.

The two students for priesthood are Stephen Sherry from Tullycorbet parish who has begun academic studies and formation at St Patrick's College, Maynooth, and Matthew Newell from Clones parish who has commenced his propaedeutic programme at the English College of St. Alban at Valladolid in Spain. In addition, Paul Flynn, Choir Director at St Michael's Parish, Enniskillen, is also progressing his studies and formation for the permanent diaconate in Clogher.

On Sunday 20th October we will mark Mission Sunday. On that day and throughout this month we will reflect on what mission means today. Traditionally, mission meant priests and nuns going to mission lands to spread the faith. That is still a huge part of the Church's missionary work. But today the mission of the Church is also here at home in our own place – and in our own hearts. As the theme of Mission Sunday puts it, "Together We Are Mission". Each of us, priests, deacons, religious and lay, are called to be witnesses and to answer the call to live out our vocation.

Pope Francis, in his message for Vocations Sunday earlier this year mentioned that *'every vocation is a summons not to stand on the shore, nets in hand, but to follow Jesus on the path he has marked out for us, for our own happiness and the good of those around us.'*
