Catholic Schools Week 23rd—30 January 2022

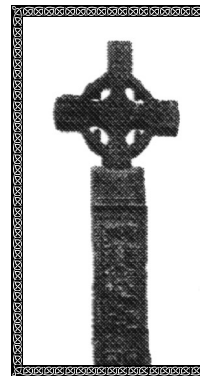
'Catholic schools aspire to create an open, happy, stimulating and mutually respectful community environment'. (Vision 08: A Vision of Catholic Education in Ireland)

This is a day set aside entirely for the celebration, study and dissemination of sacred Scripture. Scripture is a foundational part of our Catholic tradition and central to our relationship with God. It is indeed appropriate that this Sunday occurs during the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity.
