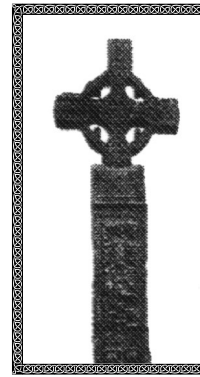
St. Joseph's Hall Bingo resumes on Friday 25th March at 9.00pm.
