

World Meeting of Families 2018 launches first digital animations on *Amoris Laetitia*

A new series of digital animations has been launched as part of the ongoing preparations for the World Meeting of Families 2018 and the visit of Pope Francis. Both of these new resources focus on *Amoris Laetitia*, the document written by Pope Francis on love in the family.

Amoris Animations

The Amoris Animations, the first created using *Amoris Laetitia* as a guiding theme, provide an accessible insight and reflection on the message in the *Joy of Love* in short, engaging and shareable cartoons. There are six animations in the series that focus on the following themes:

- 1. How families can transform the world:** how love in our families can transform our own lives and the lives of others
- 2. Love and Mercy:** Our call to be a sign of mercy; how we can be a reflection of Jesus' mercy with the ideal he sets out while never failing to show compassion to the frailty of others.
- 3. Families living as a reflection of the Trinity:** God is a communion of love and the family can be its living reflection.
- 4. Love and imperfection:** How love can overcome weaknesses, faults and imperfections
- 5. Families and consumerism:** The impact of consumerism on family life. Rejoice and celebrate what we have rather than always wanting more material things.
- 6. Families living in a digital age:** The importance of switching off our phones to give each other the time and space that love needs to flourish.

The animations have been created by Kieran O'Brien, director of the digital storytelling agency *Ministory*, based in Cardiff, Wales. His previous work includes a series of digital animations on Pope Francis' encyclical letter on care for our common home *Laudato Si'*.

As part of this animation series there are also four additional animations that have been specifically created for children. These animations will be launched at the World Meeting of Families Pastoral Congress in the RDS in August.

The themes are as follows:

- 1. Love never gives up:** how we love one another and the importance of saying please, thank you and I'm sorry.
- 2. Love needs time to grow:** The importance of spending time together and not being distracted
- 3. Love what we have:** The true joy of love is found in the little things not in having things
- 4. Love reaches out:** Keep the flow of love going, love for forgiveness and how best we can show love

Trócaire. Last year Trócaire supported projects on behalf of the Catholic Church in over 20 of the world's poorest countries. With the help of parishes throughout Ireland, they supported 2.8 million people throughout the developing world last year. Trócaire's efforts continue to be inspired by gospel values, Catholic Social Teaching and the words of Pope Francis. The Irish public donated €29.1m to support Trócaire's work in 2017/18, with the Lenten campaign continuing to be the largest campaign. The vast majority of donations to humanitarian crises - €5m - was raised by a national church collection for hunger in east Africa and Trócaire are extremely grateful for the support of the Bishops' Conference in organising this appeal. This parish contributed €4980 and £1230.
