
Tax Back Scheme for Eligible Charities

This is a tax refund in respect of tax which you have **already paid** and **will remain** with Revenue if not claimed by a Charity on your behalf.

As an eligible Charity, the Parish of Clones can claim this tax back.

Revenue allow eligible Charities to go back 4 years to reclaim tax. So if you haven't signed a CHY Certificate previously, you can sign CHY4 for the years 2013, 2014, 2015 and CHY3 for year ended 2016 (this lasts for 5 years).
