The Advent Wreath


The Advent Wreath, which has its origins in the darker regions of the Northern Hemisphere, is rich in symbolism.

The circle is a symbol of eternity - time without end. As you can go round and round the circle without coming to an end so time with God goes on and on. This is the never-endingness of God.

Evergreens stand for eternal life, life without end. Evergreens don't die in the winter and like them God is always fresh and new - he never withers and dies.

Candles remind us of Christ the 'light of the world'. We are also reminded of the candle blessed during the Easter vigil - the Pascal Candle - and of the candle given to us at our Baptism. A writer of the early years of Christianity, Tertullian, said of Christianity, 'you are a light of the world, a true evergreen'.

Four candles represent the four weeks of Advent. One candle is lit on the first Sunday and during the first week. The first and second candles are lit on the second Sunday. The red/pink candle is lit on the third Sunday, along with the other two and all four are lit on the last Sunday of Advent.
