At Communion time, everyone present is asked to approach the altar, whether receiving or not, to ensure that social distancing is maintained while leaving and re-entering seats.

A safe collection box is in place for contributions, parish envelopes and stipends. As well as this, a collector will be stationed in the porch of the Church before weekend Masses.

At the end of Mass, ushers will facilitate the safe exit of the congregation. Please follow their instructions.

All areas of the church being used are cleaned and sanitised after each Celebration.

Reader's Weekend Rota is back in operation; Eucharistic Ministers will be contacted by the Parish Office on a week-to-week basis.

We have now had a number of public Masses in Clones and the arrangements put in place by the COVID team are working well. We thank them for the time and effort they have put into keeping people safe while maintaining respect for the celebration of Mass.

We are hopeful that we will be able to continue in this way and not have to re-visit these arrangements to put a more stringent process in place. We again ask for your co-operation by:

- going to Mass once a week only
- attending a week-day Mass if possible
- leaving the spaces at Anniversary and Month's Minds Masses for the families involved

St. Macartan's, Aghadrumsee, and St. Alphonsus', Connons, will re-open in due course; this will help increase the number of people able to attend Mass.

We thank you for your patience and look forward to your continued co-operation as we move through the next few weeks.

Clones Parish Return to Public Celebration of Mass and the Sacraments

The Sunday/Holyday Mass obligation has been suspended for the time being and those who cannot attend are invited to take part virtually. So as not to deny others a chance, it is suggested that **people should go to Mass once a week only**. This respects families who wish to celebrate Anniversaries, Month's Minds etc.

Those who are sick, or in vulnerable categories or have any symptoms of COVID-19, and those who are in close contact with a person who has a confirmed or suspected case of the virus, should **stay at home** and join in the Celebration virtually.

Clones Parish COVID-19 Support Teams are present at each Mass and you are asked to follow their guidance at all times to ensure that everyone involved (priest, ministers, readers, employees, volunteers and members of the congregation) is protected appropriately.

People attending Mass should wash and sanitise their hands before leaving home, and if possible, carry their own pocket hand-sanitiser. Face coverings are advised.

To ensure a safe place outside in front of the church, we have been advised that cars should not be parked immediately in front of the chapel.

For tracking purposes, names and contact numbers must be recorded. When you enter the porch and sanitise your hands an usher will guide you to a seat; members of a household may sit together.

On the occasion of an Anniversary Mass or Month's Mind, people are invited to respect the families involved by allowing them and their relatives the available spaces.

People are encouraged to arrive at the chapel a little earlier, to allow time to go through the required protocols.

The doors of the church are kept open as much as possible to aid ventilation and to avoid contamination of door handles etc.
