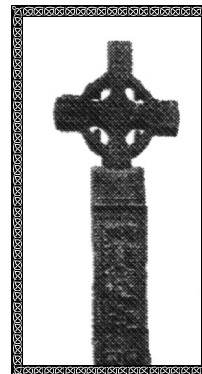
Age Concern Roslea. Thursday Variety Club resumes on 12th May 11.00am until 2.00pm. New members welcome.
