Speakers on the night will be the head of the EU commission in Ireland and a panel of agricultural experts.

**Pulsewave Ireland Heart & Artery** screening on Thursday 25th October in The Four Seasons Hotel, Monaghan. The Bpro certified to measure CASP to 99.17% in comparison to an angiogram and as seen on BBC News. As Heart Disease is still the biggest killer in Ireland they try to make it easy for everyone to be screened. Normal cost of screening is €50 per person, parish offer €30 per person which includes checks on Blood Pressure, Heart Rythm, Casp of heart, arterial flexibility and Blood flow. They can assess the risk of heart attack or stroke with a simple non invasive test. Appointments available from 11.00am until 8.00pm daily. Phone 087 7151623 to make an appointment as spaces are limited. The Screening is medically approved and each person will receive a detailed printout which they may discuss with their own GP.
